21st CCLC offers academic, social and emotional supports before and after school both during the school year and summer.

What is the 21st CCLC Program

The 21st Century Community Learning Centers (21st CCLC) program is authorized under Title IV, Part B, of the No Child Left Behind Act. The program is designed to provide academic enrichment opportunities, art, music, recreation, sports, drug and violence prevention and youth development activities to students during non-school hours. The program also offers families of students served by community learning centers opportunities for educational development.

Goals:

- To establish a **free** supplemental before school, after school and summer program that offers academic enrichment to reduce achievement gaps.
- To offer fun recreation, physical, social, and cultural enrichment.
- To provide opportunities for literacy and related educational development to families of students served.
- To provide Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM) education projects that will engage students in positive cooperative collaboration.

Who Qualifies?

We currently serve 5 schools within the Nampa School District; Columbia High School, Endeavor Elementary, Snake River Elementary, Sherman Elementary and Willow Creek Elementary. Students grades 9th-12th who live in Columbia High School boundaries are eligible to enroll. Students grades K-5th who live in Endeavor, Snake River, Sherman or Willow Creek boundaries are eligible to enroll.

Each elementary site will serve up to 32 students and our CHS site will serve up to 60 students.

- Art Activities



Busing is provided to and from programming for all students living in a serviced school boundary. During summer programming breakfast and lunch is provided, and during the regular school year a snack is provided.

Our 21st CCLC programs are FREE to our Nampa School District students who are eligible for enrollment. There are no charges for busing, snacks, field trips, or any activities.
